Innovative and gentle diagnostics.

Prostate carcinoma is the third most common tumor in men. If an elevated PSA value has been measured in your case or if your urologist has made a conspicuous palpation finding, it may be useful to perform an MRI examination of the prostate to find areas suspected of being tumors in order to enable your urologist to perform a targeted biopsy.

Prostate MRI can also make a contribution to the early detection of a malignant tumor of the prostate, since MRI of the prostate is the imaging method that can represent the prostate with the highest resolution and the highest soft tissue contrast.

In our Competence Center Prostate Diagnostics, our experts certified in multiparametric MR proststatography by the German Radiological Society (DRG) work to bundle a maximum of expertise and experience for you.

Prostate MRI (mpMRI)

We perform the so-called multiparametric prostate MRI (mpMRI) according to current guidelines. This guarantees the maximum expressiveness of the examination. Your treating urologist receives a standardized report according to PI-RADS. This is a recognized standardized diagnostic scheme that describes the most aggressive tumor sites, so that your urologist can perform a targeted biopsy and often save you repeated tissue harvesting.

If you already have a confirmed prostate carcinoma that is not clinically relevant (less aggressive tumor) and surgery has not been performed, the tumor should be actively observed ("active surveillance"). Here the mpMRI is the suitable procedure due to its high accuracy.



The examination procedure

We perform the prostate MRI on the most modern MRIs (including 3T MRI). You lie comfortably on your backs. The previously necessary insertion of a coil into the rectum is no longer necessary today. The examination takes about 30 minutes.

Necessary preparation

Special preparation is not required. Before the examination, please drink as little as possible (especially tea or coffee) to relieve your bladder. Please be sure to bring your previous findings (in particular PSA values) with you.

Important

A biopsy of the prostate should have been performed more than 6 weeks ago in order to avoid the falsification of the examination results.
